Things to Remember

Some things to remember:

1. **Sign Up:** Please sign up on our sign-up genius if you intend to come to worship on Sunday.
2. **Masks:** Face covering, like a simple cloth one, over the mouth and nose will be required throughout the worship service. Exceptions include for those with trouble breathing or with health conditions that prohibit wearing a face covering and for children under the age of 2. Parents use best judgement for face coverings for children age 2 through 10. Contact us if you have questions.
3. **Liturgy:** Our liturgy will be about an hour, with an electronic bulletin emailed each week. We are changing the Song of Adoration from a congregational hymn to a Song of Reflection during the time of prayer, sung by Jimmy. This will reduce the singing and possible spread of germs.
4. **Live-streaming** each service. If there is a problem with the livestream, it will still be recorded and posted online after.
5. **Share, pair, and prepare:** Please share the sign-up spots with others. Coordinate with individuals or families that you've spent time with recently. Prepare yourselves for many possibly many emotions when we regather: relief, sadness, joy, etc.
6. **Timing:** Please arrive early and go straight into the sanctuary for the service.
7. **Building:** It will look a little different from when you were here last. We have made some furniture rearrangements and have removed the pew Bibles and hymnals. There is also overflow seating in the Narthex.
8. **Staying at home:** If you are showing COVID-19 symptoms, or in the prior 14 days have tested positive for or have recently come in close contact with a person with COVID-19, please stay home and worship with us virtually.
9. **Nursery:** As of now, we will not be offering nursery services.
